

STUDENT SERVICES

Library and Resources

Students will have access to a computer facility on-site, and to the Mount Madonna Center library. Nearby libraries are accessible without charge in Watsonville, Santa Cruz, Aptos, Cabrillo College, the University of California (Santa Cruz), and many other locations. All required texts will be available for purchase at Oceanview Books, a store on-site, and also will be available at the library. In addition, a well stocked herbal preparations laboratory is available to students of Ayurveda.

Housing

The Institute provides on-site housing and meals for all students in an environment highly supportive to learning the Institute's disciplines. Housing is provided on-site in the facilities of Mount Madonna Center. Students have a choice from a wide range of housing options. The following per person per day rates include meals, lodging, and use of the hot tub and other facilities.

Student Assistance Services

The Institute also provides tutorial assistance, learning resources including computer and library facilities already described, faculty and peer assistance in assessing challenges and potentials, and academic counseling and career planning as part of the curriculum. No placement services are provided at this time, but a job-board is maintained.

Facilitation of study groups will be provided to encourage students to form study groups of 2-5 students each, to meet weekly in person where possible or by telephone or email where appropriate, and to take advantage of on-site facilities which will be made available for study group meetings by arrangement with the faculty member or teaching assistant most directly involved.
